## JANACEK CHAMBER ORCHESTRA

The Janacek Chamber Orchestra is among the leading ensembles of its type in the Czech Republic, and has drawn the highest international acclaim. Founded in 1964, the orchestra comprises 12 leading string musicians from the Janacek Philharmonic Orchestra, led by violinist Zdenek Dejmek. In addition to standard repertoire from the Baroque, Classical and Romantic eras, the orchestra has championed many contemporary Czech compositions.

The Janacek Chamber Orchestra has toured extensively throughout Europe, North America, Mexico and Japan and has been invited to appear at important festivals such as Toledo, Bornholm, Munich, Prague, Florence, Turku and Flanders. They have recorded on the Supraphon, RCA, Panton and Riccorde labels and have made numerous appearances on international radio and television.

Violinist Zdenek Dejmek graduated from the Ostrava Conservatory in the class of Professor Fr. Cerny and at the age of 18 won a national competition of Czech conservatory students. Shortly thereafter, he joined the Janacek Philharmonic Orchestra, where he currently holds the post of associate concertmaster. In 1966, he was appointed Music Director of the Janacek Chamber Orchestra, and has applied his extraordinary sense of ensemble and sound production in leading the orchestra to international prominence.
