Glossary of Unusual Expressions and Terms

(in order of appearance)

Act I

- Till then, enjoy your *dolce far niente* - delightful idleness
- With pleasure, nobody *contradicente* - nobody disagrees
- *Ben venuti* -welcome
- *Buon' giorno, signoriné* - Good morning, ladies
- *Gondolieri carissimi! Siamo contadine!* - Dearest gondoliers! We are peasant girls!
- *Servitori umilissimi* - most humble servants
- For whom are these flowers *bellissimi* - most beautiful flowers
- *O eccellentissimi* - Oh, most excellent ones
- *O ciel* - Oh, heavens
- Since we were short-coated - Since we wore children's clothes
- Castilian Hidalgo of 95 quarterings - Spanish nobleman, with 95 families in his heraldic shield, a fabulous noble ancestry
- Halardiers - guardsmen armed with ax-like spears
- Paladin - chivalrous knight
- Jimp - slender and elegant
- Timoneer - helmsman
- I ween - I fancy
- She'll bear away the bell - she'll take first prize
- Peruke - powdered wig
- Coutts - long-established London bank, used by royalty

Act II

- Pith - essence
- *beau ideal* - model of excellence
- Royal Levée - a court reception in morning or early afternoon
- Garter, Thistle, Bath - high orders of knighthood
- Cachucha, Fandango, Bolero - lively Spanish dances
- Xeres, Manzanilla, Montero - sherry, and varieties of it
- Tuck in his tuppenny - duck his head
- Junket, jink - words for merrymaking
- Toddy - drink of distilled spirits, used by the poorer class
- Sprats - small fish, like sardines
- Shoddy - cheap fabric made from reclaimed wool
- Double-shotted guns and colors nailed unto the mast - cannons loaded with twice the usual shot and the flat nailed so it can not be lowered in surrender
- MPs baronetted, sham colonels gazetted - Members of Parliament raised to the rank of baronet (above knight); The London Gazette listed government appointments
- Double-barrel - one with a hyphenated name, signifying status
- Merrily crying our *premé, stali* - calls used by gondolier to avoid collisions
