Margaret Daly is a free-lance cellist. She is a member of the Lake Forest Symphony, Chicago Philharmonic and Chicagoland Pops Orchestra. Margaret is also principal cellist of Chamber Opera Chicago and performs with Chicago Opera Theater. She maintains an active teaching studio in Park Ridge where she lives with her husband and two daughters.

Deborah Masloski studied at the Mozart Conservatory in Augsburg, Germany. She completed her masteres degrees at the Juilliard School and doctorate at Northwestern University. She has appeared as soloist with the New Mexico Symphony, Colorado Springs Symphony, the UNC Orchestra and Chicago Civic Orchestra. An active performer in Chicago, she has performed on WFMT radio. She teaches at Northwestern and is on the faculty of Carthage College. She resides in Lincolnshire with her husband Michael Wellem, son Christopher, and daughters Michaela and Annamarie.

Rika Seko began her professional career in Bogotá, Colombia after graduating from Tokyo University of the Arts. She served as guest Concertmaster of the Colombia Symphony and appeared as soloist with orchestras in Bogotá, Medellín, and Cali. She later served as Assistant Concert Master of the Bogota Philharmonic where she appeared as soloist in concertos and recitals throughout Columbia and Mexico. Since locating to Chicago she has performed with Chicago area orchestras including the CSO, Lyric Opera Orchestra, Grant Park and "Music Now". She lives in Evanston, Illinois with her husband Chris Hasselbring, and her daughters, Momoko and Yumiko.

Melissa Trier Kirk studied viola with Robert Swan at Northwestern University. She served as principal violist with the Fort Wayne Philharmonic before joining the orchestras of the Lyric Opera of Chicago and the Santa Fe Opera in 1982. She has performed with the Chicago Symphony, City Musick, Orpheus Band, Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival, Baroque Band, Concertante di Chicago, and Music of the Baroque. She is on the Board of Directors of the Bach Week in Evanston Festival where she is performing the Brandenburg Concerto Nr. 6 this year. She resides in Evanston with husband Lewis Kirk and daughters Ellie and Cyn.
