Currently, she teaches over fifty piano students of all ages at the Lakeshore Conservatory of Music and Schmitt Music Store in Racine. She also performs throughout Kenosha and Racine area with the Muzika Piano Trio ensemble. Serves as an accompanist for the studio of Curt Hanrahan at UW-Milwaukee and as a Music Director for the St. Patrick congregation. Mrs. Kojovic-Frodl resides in Racine with her husband Mike and her favorite little four-year old, Maya.
