

COPENHAGEN ...CONTINUED.

At right--boat landing for King and Queen. 10,000 bikes piled along the wharfs. Two large boats grabbed for smuggling dope! The Danes are much concerned about this problem. While Persia beholds them promptly when caught, the Danes are preparing islands off the coast where the peddlers, when caught, will be sentenced for life without benefits of the court. They are very concerned about the high cost of prevention, and feel it is a waste of tax money, when there are so many other worth while places for the money. The LaFross--boat from Iceland. Another large one The Anna Johavice Hus. from Greenland!

To the left--House of Frederick IV--300 years old. To the right a very high tower of Our Saviour. 1632. Now passing a large sight seeing boat--large yacht painted gold and black and red, used as apartments, and is over 100 feet long. People have been unable to find living quarters--during past three years an acute housing shortage. Large house used for mansion 1795. Herring House--cherry herring! Very large sugar refinery. Denmark's largest brewery, exporting a million bottles a year.

Koven Haven, horse guard stables. House for pilots built in 1794. Towers for very old lift bridge still in use. On left, the House of Parliament--high pointed steeple and large green roof. An enormous museum for National Exhibits. Duck your head--low bridge! Fish market--live eels and sword fish! An old lady with bag covered by rubber apron over her knees, skins the fish in just 1-2-3-moves. The eels are skinned alive, as you like it. Flounders or squid available. Scale held in one hand, fish weighed, wrapped in newspaper, "Bona Swa. Madam!" Large department store; beautiful shag rugs hung on wall; round center table all porcelain, beautiful blue trim for \$1,200 bucks. "Did you say I should wrap up two, Madam?"

ON TO HAMBURG.....

Monday night--left for Hamburg at 4:30. Rented a yellow English Ford--gear shift; four speeds ahead--small motor requires lots of shifting. Next stop, Kiel. Long rows of apartment houses, tree lined streets, red tile roofs, large fields of corn, barley, wheat and rye. Huge combines in use. Herds of Holsteins. Some grain shocked. Heavy pine forests on both sides of road. Soil very sandy. Now white houses, black roofs; new hotel, large field of cabbage, sugar beets. Road now divided by wide white lines--black top road with black top path on side for bikes, mile after mile! Again Holstein! Herd being milked in field by hand. Chicago Board of Health please note! Speedometer reads 80 kilos. 60 miles per hour! Very nice ride--large nursery and huge bed of flowers--beautiful! Two very small jets very fast overhead. Passing a Military AirPort. Huge stack of straw in field, and to the left a large lake. Very old Dutch WindMill.

KIFL.....

Entering Kiel many new structures of all kinds due to heavy damage in World War. Many flowers, and oh so clean! Stop for night at 6:10 P.M. Conti Hansa Hotel. Very high on the Brow set up. Good dinner but too much formality for comfort. Car parked underground across from large park with harbor in background. Ships unloading cranes along dock. Passenger ships from Finland. Took a short evening constitutional; saw some beautiful silver and gold plated jewelry; a large array of interchangeable stones of many colors to match the "Frau" and the "Kleina Madchens" dresses.
